The term “nonviolence” describes a commitment to treat oneself and others with deep respect. It is a belief in the basic goodness of all living things. Nonviolence is an all encompassing perspective. It includes our thoughts, feelings, words, and actions. What we think and say matters.

The philosophy and practice of nonviolence in working with children and youth applies the ideas of nonviolence to the relationship between adults and children.

Their connection allows the child to learn to be a caring and empathetic human being, fulfilling his or her own dreams and wishes and at the same time supporting the dreams and wishes of others.

Violence begets violence, while nonviolence begets nonviolence.

We help people in families, schools, and all types of agencies that serve children and families to move away from fear-based judging toward empathetic connection and fostering healthy development. And we're all about raising children with care and building loving, respectful families and communities.
