It's so easy to be told what to protect your child from sexual violence but it can be incredibly difficult to apply it in real life moments. This workshop will provide parents and caregivers with foundational information around child sexual abuse and ways to protect the children in their lives.

Participants will also engage in group activities and practices that will allow them to recognize areas of discomfort to work out in this brave

space. These same activities are ones they can use with children and aims to increase their child's protective factors.

This training will cover the following:

- CSA/SV 101
- Risk & Protective Factors
- Wall of Boulders
- Group Work

At the end of the training participants will be able to:

- Identify at least 3 risk factors for child sexual abuse
- Identify at least 3 factors that protect against child sexual abuse
- Practice at least 2 tools you can use with the children in your life
