Stephanie Blank has provided therapy to adults, children, and families for over 8 years. She is the Program Director of PROTOTYPES I-CAN Outpatient Mental Health Clinic where she facilitates supervision of clinicians who provide psychotherapy and assessment to families through the lens of nonviolence. Stephanie received her MSW from Boston University, and she is a certified parent educator for Echo Parenting & Education, bringing the philosophy of nonviolence in parenting to the clinical setting.
